Girl Power 101 Self-Empowerment Program, Girl Ages 8 - 12: Mondays

This is an interactive program planting seeds at an early age. A foundation of love, respect, appreciation and wisdom will be shared with the girls. This session will focus on "loving" yourself first, healthy eating, self-reliance, assertiveness, body image, and responsibility. Nourish the mind, body and spirit through breathing, art, yoga, listening, dance, laughter and journaling. *No classes on 2/5, 2/19, 3/5, 3/12 and 4/2. **Last day of class is May 14th.***

Cooking Up Fun, 1st-8th grade: Mondays

Not only will we be cooking and eating, we will be learning so much more! Students will learn about safety in the kitchen, how to set a table, and culinary arts skills. Students will learn about nutrition, food additives and regulations, food safety, product development and sensory evaluation. Rock Band, 4th-8th grade: Tuesdays

Historical Hand Crafts, 1st-8th grade: Thursdays
