School Readiness Checklist

Skills to ease transition

- Dressing Self and choosing clothing
- Putting on/Taking off Coat and hanging up
- Changing Shoes
- Going to the Bathroom – lifting seat, wiping, washing hands
- Blowing nose and washing hands afterwards
- Waiting for help: Becoming accustomed to needs not being met instantly
- Following directions with more than one step
- Putting away toys and clothes
- Feeding Self and sitting at a table while eating
- Helping with meal preparation and clean up
