Yoga**Preschool–2nd grade: Monday**

In Yoga, students will learn how to incorporate mindfulness in everyday life. In practicing yoga postures, breath work, and meditation they will develop resources within themselves to help combat stress and anxiety while improving focus, body awareness, and self-confidence. **Last day of class is May 11th.**

Cooking Up Fun**1st-8th grade: Monday**

Not only will we be cooking and eating, we will be learning so much more! Students will learn about safety in the kitchen, how to set a table, and culinary arts skills. Students will learn about nutrition, food additives and regulations, food safety, product development and sensory evaluation. Accommodations will be made for students with food allergies and/or dietary restrictions. **No class on April 13th. Last day of class is May 4th.**

Rock Band**3rd-8th grade: Tuesday**

Feel like a rock star! Students will have the opportunity to learn guitar, bass, drums, keyboard, and vocals. They will learn how to play their favorite songs and how to write their own. Students will get the studio experience by recording their original music and work together as team to write and perform popular music. All are welcome, regardless of musical experience. Students may bring their own instruments, but instruments will be provided. Class size is limited to 6.

Let's Build It - Crazy Circuits!**1st-6th grade: Tuesday**

In this exhilarating, cutting-edge area of engineering students will design, build, and test various circuits and electronic projects. Instructors will guide students through core concepts of electrical engineering, introducing them to circuits and electrical components through hands-on projects and experiments to explore how electricity is part of our daily lives. No previous experience is necessary, just a desire to learn and build. Projects will include: a disc launcher, electronic games, musical instruments, alarms, and more, along with fun-filled class activities! **Last day of class is May 26th.**

Zoology**K-6th grade: 2nd and 4th Tuesday of each month**

Zoologists research everything about animals including their anatomy, interrelationships, genetics, and habitats. As humans, we are intricately tied to animal life—we've depended on many of them for food, work, and friendship throughout our evolution and history. Students will learn about chicks and chickens through embryology, as well as other birds, chinchillas, guinea pigs, ferrets, turtles, and fish. A portion of the class fee will be used for feed and habitats for the animals at the school. **No class on April 14th. Last day of class is May 26th.**

Arts & Crafts**1st-8th grade: Wednesday**

Art & Crafts provides students with the opportunity to practice hands on learning experiences of current and past art and crafting trends. Mrs. McClenning will present fun projects each week. Students will have the opportunity to develop their creativity and use their problem-solving skills by constructing functional, hand crafted products and unique art pieces. Projects will include: Painting and drawing techniques, jewelry making, basket weaving, and many other fun activities.

Crochet Club**3rd-8th grade: Thursday**

Students will learn how to make a slip knot and chain stitch, the foundation for all other crocheting projects. Once that skill is mastered, we will move on to simple crochet patterns, such as single and double crochet. Depending on skill and interest of the student, we will work on more difficult patterns, the ability to read and follow a pattern, and simple projects such as scarves, washcloths, or small blankets. **No class on February 27th and May 21st. Last day of class is May 28th.**

Soccer Shots**1st-3rd grade: Tuesday and Preschool–K: Thursday**
