## First Semester Specials 2022-2023

### **Running Games**

**1<sup>st</sup>-3<sup>rd</sup> grade: Mondays**

Does your child like to run? In Running Games, students will build fitness playing games that specifically develop the foundation for running fitness, but more importantly they'll have fun. We'll meet outside rain or shine. Children should wear comfortable clothing and running shoes. (Maximum 15 students) **No class on 10/10, 11/21. Last day of class is 11/28.**

### **Strategic Board Game Club**

**4<sup>th</sup>-9<sup>th</sup> grade: Mondays**

A club that celebrates intelligence, creativity, strategy, and fun. Embrace strategic thinking, decisions that matter, learning how to work with someone else or possibly against someone else, or potentially just a way to let off some good laughter. Learn and play popular strategic board games in a casual, after-school club. Members will learn an array of games including Settlers of Catan, Ticket to Ride, Tsuro, Monopoly, Dungeons and Dragons, Battleship, Plunder, Risk, and a host of other great games! (Maximum 15 students) **No class on 10/10, 11/21. Last day of class is 12/12.**

### **Crochet Club**

**3<sup>rd</sup>-9<sup>th</sup> grade: Mondays**

Students will learn how to make a slip knot and then a chain stitch, the foundation for all other crocheting projects. Once that skill is mastered, we will move on to simple crochet patterns, such as single and double crochet. Depending on skill and interest of the student, we will work on more difficult patterns, the ability to read and follow a pattern, and simple projects such as scarves, washcloths, or small blankets. Materials provided or students may bring their own. (Maximum 15 students) **No class on 9/19, 10/10, 10/24, 11/21. Last day of class is 12/19.**

### **Yoga Fun**

**Preschool-K: Mondays**

In Yoga Fun students will learn how to incorporate mindfulness into everyday life. Learn how to calm your breath and mind, focus, increase strength and flexibility and relax through asanas (poses). (Maximum 10 students) **No class on 10/10, 10/31, 11/21. Last day of class is 12/5**

### **Soccer Shots**

**1<sup>st</sup>-3<sup>rd</sup> grade: Tuesdays and Preschool-K: Thursdays**

Soccer Shots meets once a week on the MSOL soccer field, weather permitting. Instructors are energetic and enthusiastic teachers who love working with children. We not only teach soccer skills, but also work on improving balance, coordination, and agility. Soccer Shots also teaches children important concepts such as teamwork, sharing and respect. Come join the fastest growing youth soccer program today! (Maximum 12 students per class) **Last days of classes are 10/25 for 1-3<sup>rd</sup> grade and 10/27 for Preschool-K.**

### **Chess Scholars Club**

**4<sup>th</sup>-9<sup>th</sup> grade: Tuesdays**

The purpose of Chess Club is to teach students self-improvement and problem solving through the game of chess. We will introduce students to core concepts in all phases of the game while teaching vital critical thinking skills such as forward thinking, evaluating consequences analyzing and completing ideas, recognizing patterns, and how to develop and implement a strategy. No prior chess experience is needed. Fee includes a jersey. (Maximum 10 students) **Last day of class is 11/15.**

### **Intro to Cross Country**

**4<sup>th</sup>-9<sup>th</sup> grade: Tuesdays**

Students will be introduced to the fundamentals of Cross Country (distance running) including endurance, strength, coordination, flexibility and team culture. Pace and distance (up to 3 miles) will be based on each student's ability as it grows through the course, building self-awareness and self-achievement. We'll meet outside rain or shine. Children should wear comfortable clothing and running shoes. (Maximum 15 students) **Last day of class is 11/8.**

### **Farm to Table Culinary Science**

**3<sup>rd</sup>-9<sup>th</sup> grade: Wednesdays**

We will be preparing and eating foods from the school garden but also learning about food preparation, cutting skills, nutrition, food safety, and the concept of farm to table including harvesting the school garden. All food prep will be gluten-free, dairy-free, banana-free, nut-free, and will not contain any artificial colors. Please let me know as soon as possible if there are any other food allergens that I need to be aware of for your child. (Maximum 15 Students) **No classes on: 9/21, 10/12, 11/2, 11/23. Last day of class is 12/7.**

### **MSOL Children's Choir**

**1<sup>st</sup>-9<sup>th</sup> grade: Thursdays**

Music is an essential element in the spiritual formation of children. This process cultivates a sense of responsibility, commitment, self-discipline, confidence, and poise. Participants will learn to sing two-part music and harmonization of fun songs.
